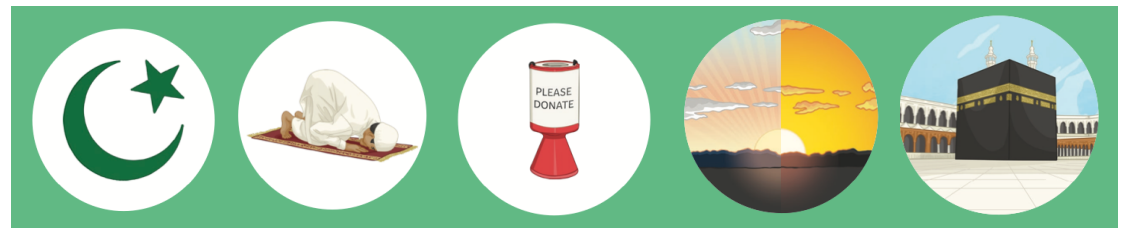
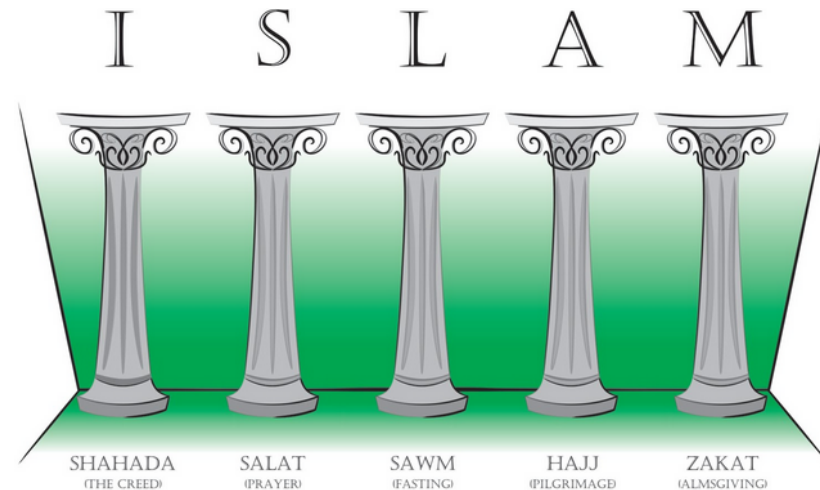


Year 2 Block 4 RE Knowledge Organiser - How does being Muslim make a difference to a family?

1. Mecca	A city in Saudi Arabia. It is the birthplace of Prophet Muhammad (pbuh) and is holy to Muslims.
2. Prophet	A messenger of a god.
3. Muhammad (pbuh)	The Prophet. Allah's messenger and the founder of Islam.
4. Qur'an	The Muslim holy book.
5. Pilgrimage	A religious journey.
6. Jum'ah	Friday prayer. This is the main gathering of Muslims for worship.
7. Eid-al-Adha	"Festival of the Sacrifice". Muslims celebrate this festival each year.
8. The Five Pillars	The core beliefs and practices of Islam. They are the foundation of Muslim life.
