Governors

At our last full governors

meeting on 17th January, we formally welcomed our newly elected parent governor and also a co-opted governor, Craig Phillips, who currently supports our school with health and safety and premises.

As part of this meeting, I asked the governors to consider the possibility of academisation, the rationale for this is as follows:

- 1. We currently receive no support from the local authority with regard to teaching, learning, curriculum, safeguarding or premises and since separating from Cambridgeshire, the possibility of support is negligible.
- **2.** The local authority has just published an inadequate children's services inspection.
- **3.** We seek support for finances, IT and premises from the OWN Trust, as we could not recruit for these positions.
- 4. During my work at the OWN Trust, I have become increasingly aware of the benefits of trust working and closer collaboration across schools, particularly in regard to curriculum, teaching and learning and leadership.
- **5.** Children at our school do not get the same number of opportunities to work with children from other schools and widen their experiences.

Following this meeting, we have registered our interest with the Regional Commissioner to explore this possibility. The next steps are for the governors and I to put a timeline together of the activities required to fully research and carry out due diligence on this process. As part of the process, your voice will be sought and your views and opinions taken into account. We will keep you updated as we progress through this piece of work.
