### Celebrate Success: Our Ofsted Report Has Arrived!

We are proud to share that following Ofsted's visit at the start of this term, we have received a very positive report that reflects the hard work, dedication and ambition of our whole school community. The inspection team were with us for two full days and spent time with pupils, staff, leaders and governors – and they saw exactly what makes Old Fletton special.

Some highlights include:

- Attendance and behaviour were judged to be of a Strong Standard, with praise for pupils' "highly positive attitudes" and the "calm, safe and fun" environment throughout.
- Our personal development programme and commitment to inclusion were both celebrated, especially the work done in PSHE, our Nest provision and the way pupils are supported. Again, this was judged to be of a Strong Standard.
- Inspectors said that "pupils are extremely well cared for," describing classrooms as "calm and welcoming" and full of "warm and caring relationships".
- We continue to meet the Expected Standard in all other areas: safeguarding, achievement, curriculum and teaching, early years and inclusion. The report recognises that our leaders know exactly what to improve and are already taking the right steps to get there.

We know there is still more to do, there always will be, especially in raising national test outcomes even further, but we are so proud of the recognition this report gives to our ethos, values and everyday efforts. Thank you to every pupil, family and member of staff who makes Old Fletton such a wonderful place to learn.

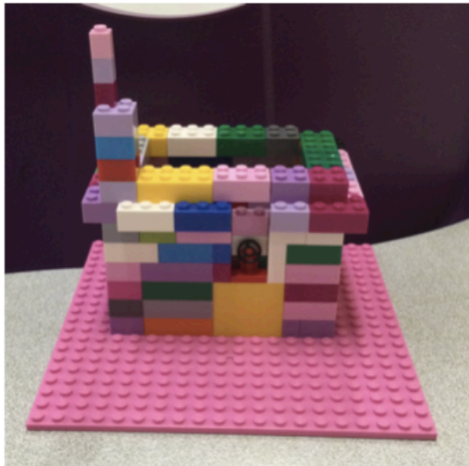
