We are writing to let you know about an important update regarding the Old Fletton Community Group.

After careful consideration, the committee has made the difficult decision to wind down the group. Over time, it has become increasingly challenging to maintain the level of participation needed to continue running the organisation in the way we would like.

Thank you to everyone who has supported us over the year—whether by volunteering time, attending events or contributing in other ways. Your support has helped create some memorable activities for the children.

We currently have a balance of £1176.40, which has been banked for the school.

At our final meeting, we agreed to hand over the running of the Tuck Shop to the Year 6 students, who will manage it on behalf of the school. This will start after the Easter Holiday. The above funds will be used to purchase a dedicated trolley and to fully stock it with treats.

The Tuck Shop will operate on the last day of each term. The next will take place after school on Friday 27th March and will be the final one organised by the Old Fletton Community Group.

Any remaining funds will be used towards a raffle prize for the Autumn Fayre.
