




Year 5 Block 3 RE Knowledge Organiser - Is there an 'Ultimate Being'?




Vocabulary

1. Faith	Belief.
2. Afterlife	Life after death.
3. Moksha	The Hindu belief in 'oneness' with God.
4. Karma	The Hindu belief that our actions determine our future existence.
5. Pacifist	A person who believes that war and violence are not justified.
6. Natural disasters	A natural event (such as a flood, earthquake or hurricane) which causes lots of damage.
7. Sinful	Wicked or immoral
8. Heaven	A place regarded in various religions as the abode of God (or the gods) and of the good after death.
9. Depiction	A representation of something (normally in a work of art).
10. Trimurti	The three forms of God in Hinduism; Brahma, Vishnu and Shiva.

Christian beliefs about life

1. Follow Jesus' teaching		Christians believe you should follow in Jesus' footsteps and live as He taught.
2. Judgement		Christians believe that you will be judged when you die, to determine whether you make it to Heaven.
3. Heaven		Christians believe that if you follow Jesus and live a good life, you will have an afterlife, in Heaven, with God.

Hindu beliefs about life

1. Samsara		Hindus believe that we are in a constant cycle of life, death and reincarnation (rebirth).
2. Karma		Hindus believe our future existence depends on our actions: good actions = good future life
3. Moksha		Hindus believe that if you follow the right path, you will reach moksha and have 'oneness with God'.
