





Year 5 Block 4 RE Knowledge Organiser - Picturing Jesus; what was he like?

1. Faith	Belief.
2. Miracle	An extraordinary event taken as a sign of the power of God.
3. Greed	Having or showing a selfish desire for more than is needed.
4. Values	Worth, usefulness, or importance in comparison with something else.
5. Conscience	A sense of right and wrong and a feeling that what is right should be done.
6. Beatitudes	Blessings given by Jesus during The Sermon on the Mount.
7. Foundation	The base for something - something which supports.
8. Inspire	To move (someone) to act, create, or feel emotions.
9. Depiction	To show (someone or something) in a picture, painting, photograph etc.
10. Representation	A sign or portrayal of something else.
11. Symbols	Something that stands for something else - a sign used to represent a quantity, position, relationship, direction, or something to be done.
12. Aspect	A certain way in which something appears or may be thought of.
13. Portray	To describe (someone or something) in a particular way - to show (someone or something) in a painting, sculpture etc.
14. Concepts	Something thought of: a general idea.
