3. Land use	The function of land - what it is used for.
4. Economic activity	The activity of making, providing, purchasing, or selling goods or services.
5. Trade	The action of buying and selling goods and services.
6. Natural resources	Materials which are sources naturally to be used for economic gain.
7. Gross Domestic Product	The total value of goods produced and services provided in a country during one year.
8. Agriculture	Farming - growing crops and rearing animals.
9. Manufacturing	The making of things on a large scale using machinery.
10. Construction	The action of building something.
11. Finite	A limited amount of something.
12. Non-finite	An unlimited amount of something.
