
Year 6 Block 1 RE Knowledge Organiser - When and how did the world come in to being?

| 1. Creation | The act of causing something to exist. |

| 4. Metaphorical | Relating to a metaphor (which describes something by comparing it to some other thing). |
| 5. Evolution | The theory that describes how all life forms developed from simpler life forms by changes that took millions of years. |
| 6. Reincarnation | The religious belief that human souls survive physical death and return in new bodies. |
| 7. Samsara | In Hinduism, the endless cycle of every soul's birth, death, and rebirth. |
| 8. Soul | The part of human beings separate from the physical body that is thought of as the center of feeling, thought, and spirit. |
| 9. Aboriginal | Native to an area; indigenous. |
| 10. Atheist | A person who believes that there is no god or gods. |
