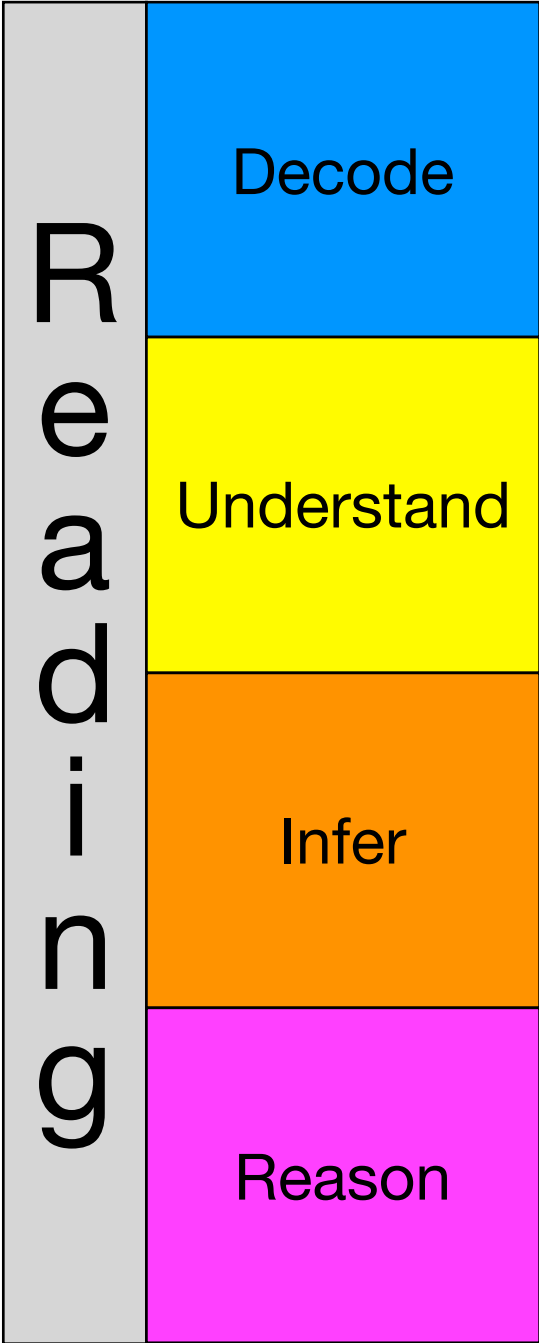

Reception

The teaching of reading in Reception is delivered through Read Write Inc. and Reading by 6 (every child in Reception reads to an adult everyday in school and reading records are updated).

Year 1

The teaching of reading in Year 1 is delivered through Read Write Inc. and Reading by 6 (every child in Year 1 reads to an adult everyday in school and reading records are updated). Year 6 children as Study Buddies support this process.

Year 2

The teaching of reading in Year 2 is delivered through Read Write Inc. for blocks 1 and 2 and then through the reading curriculum detailed below. Children who do not pass the Year 1 phonics screen continue in the appropriate Read Write Inc. group until they have caught up and then they are placed back into their year group for reading sessions.

Year 3

The teaching of reading in Year 3 is delivered through the reading curriculum detailed below. Children who do not pass the Year 2 phonics re-take continue in the appropriate Read Write Inc. group until they have caught up and then they are placed back into their year group for reading sessions. Children who are not able to catch up using the programme are identified and the SENCO organises for a Support for Learning Assessment to ascertain if there are any special educational needs. Should there be an identified need, alternative reading provision is then put in place e.g. whole word reading approach linked to precision teaching.
