S is for shoes and socks

- * Being able to put on and take off own jumper and coat**
- * Being able to take off and put back on own shoes and socks**
- * Getting changed for PE and organising clothes in their bag**

Top Tip - velcro shoes and zip coat
- dresses, proper shirts and tights are tricky on PE day



T is for talk

- * Following instructions**
- * having conversations / turn taking**
- * talking about stories**
- * waiting to say something**



A is for asking for help

- * Knowing how to say “please can you help me.”**
- * Practising asking familiar adults to help them**
 - * Being confident to ask for help**



R is for ready for new things

- * Being willing to try new foods**
- * Practising using a pen or pencil or brush**
 - * Practising using a knife and fork**
- * Being willing to try new activities**



T is for toileting independently

- * Handwashing routine / germs talk**
 - * Independent toileting**
- * Urinal and hand dryer experience**
 - * Asking to go**

Ideas for starting CARE Values at home

Celebrate success:

- *set your child little challenges and then praise them for achieving them
e.g. can you draw me a picture of everyone in our family?**

Aim high:

- * encourage your child to demonstrate their best effort
e.g. can you put hair and ears on the people in your picture to make them look even better?**

Respect:

- * encourage your child to tidy up their own toys**
- * praise children for doing jobs around the house**
- * make sure they are saying please and thank you**
- * praise your child for showing care towards another person**

Embrace a challenge:

- * ask your child to have a go at something they can't do yet
e.g. lets try to ride your bike, lets learn how to skip**
