Thank you

Our Old Fletton family continues to be a very supportive community during these unprecedented times. Your support and acceptance of changes we have had to make and continue to make has been exemplary. Thank you so much for your continued understanding. We have sent letters and information regarding children displaying Covid symptoms and what we will do in these instances, we will update these as and when the local authority inform us to do so. The **high temperature / hot to touch** criteria is very difficult to do with gloves on so please bear with us. We are NOT allowed to take children's temperatures, however if you are called and take your child's temperature at home and believe it to be within a normal range you can let us know and we can make a more informed decision together.

Consultation evenings

There will be no autumn term settling in consultations as this will break our Covid secure environment protocols. If we have any concerns regarding your child settling in to school life the teacher will call you. To enable you to examine the learning on offer we will send books home over half term. These books must be placed in a sealed plastic bag by the Thursday of half term so they are suitably quarantined for the required 72 hours before being allowed back in school. Should you have any queries about the learning following looking at the books please email the office with your child's name and details of your query and they will let the teacher know to give you a call.

Coming soon

1. The use of Microsoft Teams for home learning as part of CLOOS (homework) and for in the event of a local lockdown or bubble closure.
2. Lexia Core 5 - an online personalised reading programme for children in years 3-6 to support reading at home as well as interventions at school.
3. Feedback and marking policy - to reduce unnecessary teacher workload we are looking at best practice and removing teachers recording in individual children's books and using a mark book system for targeting improvements. This means you will see little or no comments in children's books.
