We have seen an increase of 20% (163/229) of children accessing and meeting their usage targets which is a fantastic improvement. Parents of the 66 children not meeting targets should contact school if this is due to technical issues otherwise children will be challenged in school about the lack of usage. I am passionate that we get to 100% of children using this resource and intend to extend it further by offering similar provision in maths.
