1	<p>Welcome & apologies</p> <p>Mrs Levy welcomed all the class representatives to the meeting.</p>
2	<p>Teaching in base classes</p> <p>Mrs Levy explained that we are currently reviewing the curriculum which will result in having more time spent on other subjects such as History, Geography, etc. To enable more flexibility in the teaching of all subjects and allow more opportunities to attend out of school events such as sports festivals we are considering moving back to teaching in base classes.</p> <p style="background-color: yellow;">Class representatives are to ask their class what they think about going back to base class vs the current groupings.</p>
3	<p>Mixing classes</p> <p>Mrs Levy shared the idea of mixing up the classes each year. She explained the thinking behind this - when children join the school in Reception and are put into a class they remain in that class for 7 years. Whilst in Reception, friendship groups are made across both classes and children may not be in the same class as some of their friends.
