As we look forward to welcoming you back on Monday 8th March please may I kindly request that as your children return so must the technology that school has provided during lockdown - this includes any devices provided by school to access Lexia at home. The government have made it very clear that attendance is mandatory and so we will resume our normal attendance monitoring from that date. As tempting as it may be to want to catch up with friends and family after being in lockdown I must urge you not to arrive at school early before your allotted times to avoid overcrowding and certainly not stand chatting with other households as the guidance is very clear that adults not maintaining social distancing remains the biggest risk factor.

Friday 5th March

As mentioned in my last update we are looking at the Haringey Curriculum and we have received notification of training on Friday 5th March. To ensure all teachers can attend this online event quizzes and an away from screen time activity will be provided that morning. Children in school will be supervised by support staff and the last day of remote learning will resume as normal after lunchtime. Class teachers will be in touch with details of what to expect.

Reopening Curriculum

It is our intention for the first two weeks back for our children and teachers to spend time reviewing the learning that has been offered during lockdown to ascertain what has been understood and retained by the children. We will carry out structured assessments once children have settled back into routine. We are accessing the national tutoring programme partly funded by the government, partly funded by school and will use this resource which has been designed to catch up children in key stage 2. We will be in touch directly if it involves your child.

The Year 6 teachers and I are looking at how school can reward these children for this significant achievement. A huge congratulations to all!
