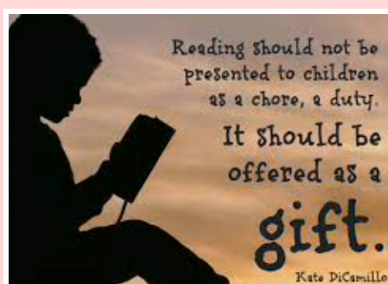

Storytime Top Tips

1. Make it a treat
2. Make it a special quiet time
3. Show curiosity
4. Chat about the story
5. Read the story once without stopping
6. Avoid testing with questions
7. Link to other stories and experiences
8. Read favourites over and over again
9. Use different voices
10. Love the book
