## Vocabulary

1. Object	Material thing that can be seen and touched.
2. Materials	Matter from which a thing is or can be made from.
3. Volume	The amount of space that an object occupies or takes up.
4. Properties	Features that can be measured like colour, volume, length or hardness.
5. Measure	Find out the size or amount of an object.
6. Group	Put objects together with similar properties such as transparency, hardness or volume.
7. Results	Information obtained or got by experiment or scientific method.
