This year's theme is Gadgeteers and has been developed in partnership with the Science Museum Group. You can sign up at your local library for free and, by reading library books over the summer holiday, children can collect stickers to complete their collector's poster and help the Gadgeteers create inventions and plan an epic summer party. Children who finish at least six books by the end of the challenge will receive a special Gadgeteers bookmark and earn a certificate.
