## Unit objective: To talk about your family/a family in French


By the end of this unit we will be able to:

- Silent letters: 's' not pronounced in appelles, ans, soeurs, mes grandparents, les or parents.
- Elision eg je m'appelle/il s'appelle/elle s'appelle drop the 'e', replace with apostrophe and attach to word that follows which begins with vowel or mute 'h'.
