## Phonics & pronunciation we will see:

- Elision: J'habite dropping last letter of a word and replacing it with an apostrophe

## Grammar we will learn:

- 2) learning 1st person singular high frequency verb j'habite from the verb HABITER;
- 3) using the negative structure il y a (there is) & il n'y a pas de/d' (there is not)
